# FOOD SAFETY

REFRIGERATED OR FROZEN FOODS MAY NOT BE SAFE TO EAT AFTER A POWER OUTAGE. USE THESE TIPS TO MINIMIZE FOOD LOSS AND REDUCE RISK OF ILLNESS.



Refrigerated food will last **4 HOURS** in an outage. After 4 hours, place refrigerated food into a cooler with ice.



Frozen food will last **24 HOURS** in a half-full freezer and **48 HOURS** in a full freezer.



Keep your refrigerator and freezer doors closed as much as possible during an outage.
