
# a frigid fact:

#### HERE'S WHY:

In cold weather, your heating system works much harder to keep your home comfortable. Even if you don't change your thermostat setting, it runs longer to heat your home.



Even gas heating systems use electricity to power the fan and distribute the warm air.

# **ENERGY USE MATTERS**

Your monthly bill is largely determined by the amount of energy you use.

## **ENERGY USED**

The meter on your home measures the energy you consume.

This is your "usage."



### **ELECTRIC RATE**

There is a charge or each kilowatt hour you use. This is your "rate."
