5 ENERGY SAVING TIPS FOR SUMMER



Raise your thermostat 2–3 degrees to reduce strain on your air conditioner works. A small adjustment can help lower energy usage.



Change your HVAC air filters regularly to keep air flowing efficiently. Dirty filters force your unit to work harder and use more electricity.



Run large appliances like the dishwasher, washer, and dryer after 8:01 p.m. during Off-Peak hours, when electricity costs are lower.



Seal air leaks around doors and windows to prevent cool air from escaping. This helps you stay comfortable without overworking your HVAC.



Use blinds or curtains to block sunlight during the day. This helps keep indoor temperatures cooler and reduces your air conditioner use.
