

Stay cool & safe this summer!



While AC units and fans keep you cool in the summer, they can also pose dangers in your home.

LEARN HOW YOU CAN PREVENT THESE RISKS.

- Schedule professional AC maintenance to inspect the appliance for any issues that could lead to a fire.
- Change your air filter every 30 – 60 days.
- Inspect your outdoor unit periodically to ensure it has proper airflow, remove debris and clean the condenser unit.
- Do not plug your window AC unit into an extension cord or power strip. It should have its own dedicated outlet.



DOS AND DON'TS: THUNDERSTORMS & LIGHTNING



- DO go to low areas like a valley or ravine & avoid tall buildings and trees
- DON'T stay in large groups of people
- DO stay away from metal objects, especially tall objects
- DON'T stand by lakes, ponds, or even damp grass
- DO stay in your vehicle until the storm passes if you're driving
- DO avoid windows, doors, plumbing and electrical equipment inside your home
