LOOK UP WHEN...

- Using tools of any kind, especially when trees are nearby.
- Using cranes or other lifting devices that approach working distance within 20 feet of power lines.
- Putting up scaffolding, framing a building, painting, pruning trees or picking fruit.
- Moving a tree under a power line. Determine the overhead clearance from the top of the tree. Trees can conduct electric current.
- Working on top of buildings.
